Mangere Swimming Club Terms and Condition's

Annual Subscription Fee (current structure, the following effective from 1st July 2014)

***Please note the New Zealand "swim year" is 12 months beginning 1st July to 30th June each year*

To become a member of the Mangere Swimming Club the following **FEE payment** conditions will apply.

Note! Mangere Swimming Club reserves the right not to accept any membership applications for any reason it may think fit

1. Membership Joining Fee (includes Returning and Transfer Swimmers)

If you are enrolling your child or children for the first time you will be required to pay a one off **Joining Fee plus the Annual Subscription Fee (See Fee Schedule1)**.

Joining Fee includes swimmer pack-Club Polo Shirt, Swimming Cap and Goggles for each and consecutive new swimmer from one Family
If you enroll one child and would like to enroll a second and consecutive child at a later time the family rate discount still applies

2. Changing training days or number of sessions

Your child's coach will discuss with you should an increase for your child training sessions be required. *E.g. level of swimming has improved.*

- A. Parents wanting to change training days must consult with the Coach Coordinator. If there is space for your child on another night your coach will let you know. Parents **MUST NOT** change nights without going through the correct channels.

The Coach Coordinator must inform the Club Treasurer if a child's session's change at any time, adjustments will be made accordingly.

3. Overdue Accounts:

- If your membership account is in arrears for a period of 1 (one) month as set out in the Mangere Swimming Club Constitution Rule 14 Para 3 you are Non-Financial and must not take part in the activities of the Club (Swimming). You must *either*

A. Pay the overdue amount in full; OR

B. Arrange a payment option with the Club Treasurer to bring the overdue amount up to date; Arrears must be cleared within 14 days or as agreed by Club Treasurer

- If your membership account is in arrears for a period of 2 (two) months as set out in the Mangere Swimming Club Constitution Rule 14 Para 4 you cease to be a member of MSC. Your membership will be suspended and Swimming Counties Manukau will be notified.
- Notwithstanding the proceeding provisions Mangere Swimming Club Committee shall have the right to remit the Subscription arrears by any member for any reason it may think fit.

4. Refunds:

No refunds are given for missed training sessions Ref 5 & 7.1

5. Inactive Swimmers:

This clause will apply to any member who is unable to swim for a consecutive period of 15 days up to (2) two months being a maximum term applied for an Inactive Swimmer Fee. **Refer to Fee Schedule**

The member's monthly subscription fee may be reduced to an Inactive swimmers fee for;

A. Medical illness or injury requiring long term treatment. (Medical Certificate required as proof)

B. Or other "Special Circumstances". At the discretion of Mangere Swimming Club Committee

The decision to extend an Inactive Swimmer Fee for members will be at the discretion of the Mangere Swimming Club Committee

6. Financial Assistance:

Mangere Swimming Club may assist Coaches, Parents, Team Managers and Swimmers financially for Mangere Swimming Club *approved Courses*. Application and Reimbursements of such financial assistance please refer to Document FA01-2014.

7. Event Entries & Fees:

Set as per hosting Swimming Club – **NO LATE ENTRIES ACCEPTED**– All entries must be confirmed with respective coach.

Mangere Swimming Club Recorder will advise parents via email of their child's confirmed event entries and entry fees for each meet.

All entry fees must be paid before each meet takes place or your child's entry will not be processed.

7.1 Scratching / Withdrawals: Scratching or Withdrawals are not guaranteed once entries have been sent to the hosting club and may incur a penalty fee as per hosting club meet rules.

Late withdrawals or scratching may be accepted due to medical reasons however proof may be required and the decision will be at the discretion of the club hosting the meet.

NO REFUNDS will be given if a swimmer does not turn up to a meet they are entered into

8. Transfers: Transfer forms will not be approved until all outstanding moneys owing to Mangere Swimming Club and Fees are paid in full (SNZ regulation). A minimum of 2 weeks will be required for completion of paperwork.

9. Termination of membership: Must be advised in writing to the Club Secretary ONE MONTH prior to withdrawing membership. The member will be required to pay up to the end of that month, including all remaining arrears.

10. Swimming Attire: It is compulsory for swimmers representing Mangere Swimming Club to wear correct swimming attire when attending all meets including goggles and Mangere Swimming Club branded Swim Cap. The Club colours are orange, black and white.
