

Strive to Achieve Program

Objective

To recognise, reward and encourage Neptune swimmers strive to achieve, times set annually by the committee for all ages over four levels of achievement; Gold, Silver, Bronze and Green.

Eligibility Criteria

Open to all Neptune members who

- Is currently registered financial member within the SNZ database
- Have NOT obtained a qualifying time for a National meet ie: NZ Junior Festival, NZ Division II Competition, NZ Age Group, NZ Opens or NZ Short Course Championships
- Strive to Achieve will recognise times between 1 July 2018 to 30 June 2019
- Times can ONLY be obtained at Ribbon Night
- Only individual times will be recognised

Achievement Standard Required

• Archive the required time standard in at least 2 different strokes within the same one category ie: Silver - 50 Free and 100 IM or Green – 50 Fly and 50 Free

Recognition and Reward

Neptune swimmers who qualify for the Strive to Achieve will receive the following recognition and reward:

- Special Neptune Strive to Achieve shirt, presented at our annual prize giving
- Publication of their name on the Neptune Swim Club website
- Invitation to attend two local inter-club short course meets a year as part of the Neptune Swim Club team
 - all meet entry fees will be refunded once final psych sheets have been published
 - selected meets for 2018-2019 are
 - Kiwi Challenge
 - Taieri Carnival

Note: where a swimmer, for example, turns 13 years of age during the season and records times as both a 12 years and 13 years, he/she will receive a Strive to Achieve reward depending on the highest standard achieved in either (not both) of those age groups – i.e. gold, silver, bronze or green.
